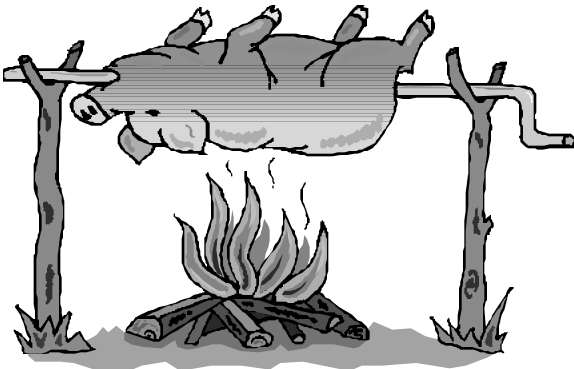

# BASTILLE DAY IN CARONDELET

Bastille Day is a National holiday in France. It is very much like Independence Day in the U.S. because it is a celebration of the beginning of a new form of government. The Bastille was a prison in France that the kings and queens often used to lock up the people that did not agree with their decisions. To many, it was a symbol of all the bad things done by the kings and queens. On July 14<sup>th</sup>, 1789, a large number of French citizens gathered together and stormed the Bastille and released the prisoners. Eventually King Louis the XVI and his wife, Marie Antoinette were executed by guillotine. People in France celebrate the "storming of the Bastille" as the beginning of the French Revolution and ultimately created a government where the people rule themselves.

In recognition of its French heritage, Carondelet will celebrate Bastille Day on July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at South St. Louis Square Park, 7700 So. Broadway, St. Louis, MO. Carondelet was founded by the Frenchman Clement Delor de Treget in 1767. In 1794 it was named Carondelet in honor of the Baron De Carondelet, the Governor General of the Spanish Louisiana Province. Eventually the annexation of Carondelet to the City of St. Louis took place in April, 1870.

The celebration will consist of a sidewalk Art Fair, Flea Market, Storming of the Bastille, the execution of King Louie and Marie Antoinette by guillotine, a farmer's market, re-enactors dressed in period clothes, music from 11 am - 4 pm and refreshments. The Flea Market will open at 6 am.
